Peace Cathedral

Celebrant:

God of compassion and mercy, God of beauty and love, show yourself to the faithful who call upon your name. Accept from my sinful hands this frankincense as you used to accept prayers and supplications from all your children, from generation to generation.

As this incense is rising before you God and fills up this room with sweet smell, so fill our hart, mind and soul with the fragrance of the knowledge of your Son Jesus Christ, our Lord.

Let my prayer be set before you like incense; the lifting up of my hands like the evening sacrifice.

and to the Son,
and to the Holy Spirit!
Amen!**

Celebrant:

Almighty God, we confess before you all the sins we have committed by thoughts, words and deeds. We confess that we have failed to love you the way you love us. We have failed to love both neighbors and enemies the way your children should love.

Forgive us the sins that everybody sees.

Forgive us the sins that nobody sees apart from us.

Forgive us sins that only you can see.

Deacon: Amen!

Celebrant:

Almighty God, who pardons all who truly repents, pardon and deliver you from all your sins and guilt,

Deacon: Amen!

Celebrant:

By the authority that God grants His/Her church I declare to you: Your sins are forgiven, Your guilt is wiped out. You are free to live and love in Jesus Christ.

Deacon: Glory be to God

Celebrant:

The Grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and the Love of God the Father and the Communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all.

Congregation: And with your Spiri

Celebrant: Let us lift our hearts.

Congregation: We lift them to the Lord.

Celebrant: Let us give thanks to our Lord.

Congregation:

It is right indeed to worship Father, Son and Holy Spirit: the Most Holy Trinity, one in Essence and undivided.

Celebrant:

It is right to hymn you,

Who the firmament by Your power and might created,
caused your creatures to breathe with a spirit from on high,
earth with its myriad forms assigned to us humans for our dwelling.

O God, who art One, who giv'st to each shape each showing.
Be Though my defender: Shield me, grant me the power Satan to vanquish,
love's desire until death to cherish; Lighten for us our load of sins in the final hour.

Celebrant:

You, who art Sunny night and the light who shins in the darkness; Holy Spirit, Spirit of Comfort and Paraklite.

We give thanks to you for this liturgy, which we offer you from our hearts and minds. Therefore, with thousands of archangels and tens of thousands of angels, the cherubim and seraphim and all the company of heaven we are singing, crying and shouting the triumphal and celestial hymn and saying:

Congregation:

Holy, Holy, Holy, the Lord God Almighty, heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest

Celebrant:

With all these powers, o Lord, we also cry aloud and say: Holy, are you, God, and all holy and magnificent is your glory; who so loved your world, as to gave your only begotten Son that all who believe in him should not perish but have eternal life;

In the night in which he was betrayed for the life of the world, He took bread in his holy, pure and blameless hands and when he gave thanks and sanctified and broke it, he gave it to his disciples and apostles saying: "*Take, eat this is my body which is broken for, you, for the remission of sins!*"

Celebrant:

In the same way, after the supper, he took the cup saying: Drink from this, all of you; this is my blood of the New Covenant, which is shed for you and for many for the remission of sins.

Congregation: Amen

Celebrant:

Remembering therefore this commandment of yours and all those things that have come to pass for our sake: The cross, the tomb, the resurrection on the third day, the ascension into heaven, the sitting at the right hand, and the second coming, o Lord we give you thanks.

Congregation:

We sing to you, we bless you; we give you thanks to you, o Lord, and pray to you, our God.

Celebrant:

We ask you, we pray and we implore you: send down your Holy Spirit upon us and upon us and these gifts to be for us the body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Celebrant: The body of our Lord Jesus Christ was broken for us.

We break this bread for those who love God, for those who follow the path of Islam, Judaism, Buddhism or any other faith traditions, so that one day we may be as one.

Deacon: Amin

Sub-deacon: Bell tolling!

Choir: "Kyrie eleison"

We break this bread for all of creation which groans with pain, like the pain of childbirth: our green earth and all its inhabitants – human beings, animals, birds and all the living creatures, - and also for destroyed forests, fields and flowers, contaminated waters and air, that one day God's creation will be restored.

We break this bread for those who have no bread, the starving, the homeless and the refugees, that one day this planet may be a home for everyone.

We raise this cup for the depressed, for the hopeless, and those who are tormented by fear and guilt, that one day they find comfort in Christ.

We raise this cup for those who are forgotten, the crying and for those nobody prays for, so that one day they find happiness in Christ

Deacon: We thank you for their lives and example.

Celebrant:

We thank you, o Lord, for counting us worthy to call upon you, the God of Heaven and Earth, as Father, and say:

Congregation:

**Our Father who art in heaven,
hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come,
thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread
and forgive us our trespasses
as we forgive those who trespass against us
and lead us not into temptation,
but deliver us from evil.**

Celebrant:

For thine is the kingdom the power and the glory of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, now and forever and to ages of ages.

Congregation: Amen

Celebrant:

With reverence to God, with faith and with love to the neighbor, draw near and receive this bread and wine as Disciples of Christ, remembering that the body of our Lord was broken for us, and the blood of our Lord was shed for us on the Calvary.

Come, Come, Whoever You Are,

Wonderer, worshipper, lover of leaving.

It doesn't matter. Ours is not a caravan of despair.

Come, even if you have broken your vow a thousand times.

Come, yet again, come, come to the Lord

Celebrant: We thank you o Lord, who loves humankind, for counting us worthy to participate in your Holy Communion. Bless and protect us, for we are cleansed in you and to you we worship One God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

Deacon: Amin!

Celebrant: Lord bless who have been created in your image and likeness, Bless your faithful and worshipers who love your beauty. Do not forget who have their trust in you.

Deacon:

Grant your Peace to entire world and its inhabitants _ the orphans and widows, the poor and sick, the hungry and thirsty, prisoners and refugees, the side-lined shelterless, for all good and perfect gifts come from you, Father of the Light. We praise and worship you One God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit!
